Using new (and the not so new) technologies in the work of Volunteer Management

Facilitated by Mark Creyton with special guest presenters

These four forums will provide the chance for Volunteer Managers to gain an understanding and work with a variety of information and communication technologies to improve their practice in Volunteer Management. This is an exciting series which will provide the chance for discussion of ideas and approaches, as well as the chance for practical learning.

1. Understanding the new technologies and their role in Volunteer Management

10 August 2009

9.30am - 12.30pm

This forum will examine a variety of new and not so new technologies and how they can assist Volunteer Managers. We will be considering different internet sites, exchanges and Skills Bank, explaining the uses of wiki, blogging and common source approaches, as well as social networking sites such as Facebook and Twitter. We will also be examining some of the future technologies and how they can be utilised to enhance the work of Volunteer Management. The forum will provide an excellent introduction for those new to these approaches while also demonstrating innovative uses for the more experienced.

2. Recruiting, Managing, Retaining and Rewarding via the new technologies

14 September 2009

9.30am - 12.30pm

This forum will look at the practical ways you can promote your organisation through your own and other online volunteer sites. We will also look at different ways you can orient, support and retain your volunteers using these new tools and hence save time working with new ways of engagement. Special focus will be given to the way young volunteer leaders are using these technologies to create effective virtual volunteer communities.

3. Networking, Informing and Learning via the new technologies

12 October 2009

9.30am - 12.30pm

This forum will explore how Volunteer Managers in Queensland can benefit from the new technologies to more effectively network and share ideas. In this workshop we will plan future ways in which Volunteering Queensland can provide support in virtual networks and provide virtual education and learning. The use of pod-casts and various alternative approaches to keep you up-to-date will be considered.

4. Corporate Volunteering Virtually

9 November 2009

9.30am - 12.30pm

This forum will examine a range of ways in which corporate volunteers can be recruited and worked with online. The forum will profile innovative corporate community partnerships and open up new avenues for volunteers and for volunteer managers.
